

## Long-term trends in domestic violence related murder






## Relationship between victim of DV murder and perpetrator

#### Adult female victims

78% of adult female victims were murdered by an intimate partner


Relationship type adult female victims, 5 years to Jun 25 (n=58)



#### **Child victims**

93% of child victims were murdered by a family member


Relationship type child victims, 5 years to Jun 25 (n=28)



#### Adult male victims

**35%** of adult male victims were murdered by someone other than a partner or family member, e.g. a flatmate

Relationship type adult male victims, 5 years to Jun 25 (n=60)





### Long-term trends in intimate partner murder






## Nature of the intimate partner relationship

**41%** or 24 victims were murdered by a current spouse or partner 17 women and 7 men

**42%** or 25 victims were murdered by a current or ex-boyfriend/girlfriend 17 women and 8 men





### Perpetrators of intimate partner murder





100% of adult female victims were murdered by a male intimate partner



**71%** of adult male victims were murdered by a female intimate partner



### Nature of the family relationship



**44**% of victims of family murder were children 17 boys and 9 girls

80% were murdered by a parent/guardian


**56**% of victims of family murder were adults


