Summary of Characteristics

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

(a) General information

The New South Wales Inmate Census was conducted as part of the National Australian Prison Census for the 30th June 1999. The proposal for a National Prison Census first emerged at a Correctional Administrators meeting in Melbourne in September 1980 as an offshoot from a review of correctional statistics. Preliminary technical discussions were held in December 1980 and a formal proposal went to the Ministers Conference held in New Zealand in April/May 1981. The Ministers discussed the proposed census at some length and finally agreed to conduct the first Australian National Prison Census on 30th June 1982 and that an inmate census should continue to be conducted annually.

(b) Scope of data collection

This publication contains summary statistics of inmates held in full-time custody in gazetted correctional centres in New South Wales at midnight on the 30th June 1999 and of inmates with a "live" order for periodic detention for the week ending Sunday 27th June. Full-time inmates on the Work Release II programme (under which the inmate lives at home and works at a correctional centre) have been included. Inmates temporarily absent from a correctional centre under s29(1) of the Correctional Centres Act, 1952 have been excluded with the exception of those inmates housed at the Parramatta Transitional Centre. These inmates are shown separately (Section 4) and are not included in any totals. Inmates housed in police/court complexes (places of detention not gazetted as correctional centres) under the supervision of Departmental staff have not previously been included in this publication, and are shown separately (Section 5). These inmates are not included in any totals for inmates held in gazetted correctional centres.

(c) Concept of an episode of imprisonment

Statistical information describing inmate legal status, type of sentence, court type, sentence terms, legal status, most serious offence etc. all relate to the episode of imprisonment current at the 30th June 1999. For the purposes of this publication, an episode of imprisonment is taken as a continuous period of imprisonment within an adult correctional centre in NSW.

In distinguishing between the current and any previous episode of imprisonment the following rules were applied:

- for inmates held in custody for breach of a parole or licence order relating to a previous period(s) of imprisonment, the previous period(s) of imprisonment is/are excluded from the current episode (this rule changed in 1998, refer to note (k));
- any period of imprisonment prior to a release to a court where the inmate was subsequently freed without having been returned to a correctional centre within 1 day, was excluded from the current episode;
- any period of imprisonment prior to a release to Police custody where the inmate was subsequently freed without having been returned to a correctional centre within 5 days, was excluded from the current episode;

- iv. any period of imprisonment prior to release on bail, on a bond or to immigration authorities was excluded from the current episode;
- v. any period of imprisonment prior to transfer to an institution other than a NSW correctional centre (e.g. a psychiatric hospital, juvenile or interstate institution) was excluded from the current episode;
- vi. for inmates who had escaped from a correctional centre and had been subsequently returned to custody, the episode of imprisonment current at the time of the escape was included in the current episode;

(d) Known prior imprisonment as an adult

For the purposes of this publication this category includes inmates with a known prior episode of imprisonment, including episode/s on remand, in a gazetted NSW adult correctional centre. For the first time in 1999, a hierarchy of sub-categories based on custodial program and legal status of the episode(s) of prior imprisonment is included. Where there is more than one sub-category of prior imprisonment, the highest level category is used. The sub-categories from lowest to highest supervision level are:

- (a) an episode of periodic detention,
- ii an episode on remand in a full-time correctional centre,
- iii. an episode in full-time custody for fine default,
- iv. an episode in full-time custody under sentence.

(e) English speaking status of country of birth

Country of birth classification is based on the Standard Australian Classification of Countries (SACC) (Australian Bureau of Statistics Catalogue No: 1269.0, ABS 1998). English speaking status of the country of birth is based on the "Main English speaking countries" as identified in ABS publication "Australian Standard Classification of Countries for Social Statistics" (ASCCSS) (ABS Catalogue No. 1269.0). The main English speaking countries comprise: Australia, Canada, Republic of Ireland, New Zealand, South Africa, United Kingdom (England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland) and the United States of America.

(f) Legal status

For the purpose of this publication, inmates have been classified to the following eight legal status categories:

- i. under sentence no appeal;
- ii. convicted but awaiting sentence;
- iii. awaiting result of appeal against conviction or sentence:
- iv. detained as a forensic patient;
- v. unconvicted (awaiting court hearing/trial);
- vi. awaiting deportation;
- vii. awaiting extradition to another jurisdiction or
- viii. civil inmate (held in custody for an offence other than a criminal offence).

(g) Type of sentence

This item relates to the aggregate sentence imposed (see below). Inmates held in full-time custody (convicted or unconvicted) who also have a current order for periodic detention are counted as full-time custody inmates. The category "Life" includes persons sentenced to Life imprisonment prior to introduction of the Sentencing Act, 1989 and those subsequently sentenced to "Natural" Life under the current legislation. This category also includes inmates who have a set minimum term with an additional term of "Life".

A new fine enforcement system for NSW was introduced from 27 January 1998 under the Fines Act 1996 and is based on a hierarchy of civil and non-custodial sanctions with imprisonment as a sanction of last resort. An amnesty on the execution of fine default warrants operated from 1 October, 1997 until the new legislation came into effect. Inmates with a sentence type of "Fine default" in 1999 were serving federal or interstate fines.

(h) Level and State of court

This item represents the level and State of court at which the current sentence for the most serious offence (see below) was imposed. For unsentenced inmates, the court at which the most recent order for detention for the most serious offence (see below) is used. Appeal courts were recorded only where such courts have altered the length of sentence relating to the most serious offence. Where the most serious offence recorded is Breach of Parole/Licence the court of conviction is shown as Parole Board. Inmates detained for reason of deportation only are shown under "Immigration Authority".

The NSW Drug Court program commenced on February 8, 1999 as a non-custodial program for illicit drug dependant offenders charged with non-violent offences. Convicted offenders are placed on a Drug Court order for intensive supervision programs combined with medical treatment services. Inmates shown with a court of conviction of "Drug Court" were held in custody for breach of a Drug Court order.

(i) Classification of offences

In this publication offences have been classified according to the Second Revision of the New South Wales Classification of Offences and of Care and Protection Orders for Children. This classification was developed by the NSW Office of the Australian Bureau of Statistics in collaboration with State authorities and has been used in NSW Correctional Centres and courts statistics since 1973.

As a general rule, a legal charge of attempting, conspiring, or inciting to commit a crime, or aiding in the commission of, or participating as an accessory before the fact to a crime is classified to the offence category to which the crime so attempted, etc. is assigned. However, cases of accessory after the fact to a crime are assigned to the category "Accessory after the fact". While the classification has, of necessity, been abbreviated in the tables that follow, detail of the specific offence groups included within each offence category are given in the Appendix.

(j) Most serious offence

Although an inmate may be held in a correctional centre for a number of different offences, only the most serious offence in the current prison episode has been recorded in these statistics. The most serious offence is the offence for which the longest sentence was passed for a single count regardless of the possible result of any appeals. Where no sentence had been passed at 30 June 1999, or two different offences had equal sentences, the offence with the lowest (NSW) offence code number was chosen. Prior to 1998 "Breach of parole/licence" was only taken as the most serious offence when there were no other current convictions for another offence. Under new counting rules introduced in 1998 (see note (k) below) the offence of "Breach of parole/licence" is treated the same as any other offence.

(k) Breach of parole/licence order - new counting rule

A new counting rule for inmates held in custody for offences relating to a breach of parole or licence order was introduced in 1998. In previous years all inmates who had been discharged to parole/licence that had been returned to custody prior to expiration of the parole/licence term were classified as "breach of parole/license" inmates. In 1998 and 1999, only those inmates who had a conviction for Breach of Parole or Licence at the time of the census are classified as "breach of parole/licence" inmates.

As in previous years breaches relating to juvenile orders or orders from other jurisdictions (with the exception of the ACT) are ignored.

A new rule for determining "current episode" for inmates held in custody for offences relating to a breach of parole or licence order was also introduced in 1998. In previous publications the current imprisonment episode for these inmates included the previous period(s) of imprisonment relating to the breached order(s). In this publication, these prior episodes are excluded from the current episode of imprisonment. This rule makes it possible for the most serious offence to be "Breach of Parole" or "Breach of Licence". A new offence category has been created to identify these offenders.

(I) Aggregate sentence

This item represents the longest period that a person may be detained under sentence in the current episode and includes any additional terms. The aggregate sentence for "Forensic Patients" and "Life" sentence types is indeterminate as the court does not set a sentence expiry date. Pending charges that are likely to extend the aggregate sentence are ignored. In the case of an inmate serving the balance of a sentence after revocation of parole or licence, only the balance of the sentence is included, as distinct from previous publications where the whole of the original sentence was included (refer to note (k) above).

(m) Inmate security classification

Inmates in full-time custody are classified in accordance with the Correctional Centres (General) Regulation 1995 (Clauses 10 and 11). A new classification system for female inmates was introduced on 4 July 1997 (Clause 10 (1A) see Prisons (General) Amendment Classification of Female Inmates) Regulation 1997). Inmate classification sub-categories for unsentenced inmates who have been classified were introduced into this publication in 1999. In previous publications all unsentenced inmates were counted as

"Remand/Trial" inmates regardless of whether they had been otherwise classified by the Department. In this publication the inmate classification current at the 30th June is shown. It should be noted that some convicted inmates may have an "unconvicted" inmate classification if they were facing further and more serious charges or they had not been re-classified at the time of the census.

An administratively based classification system for periodic detainees was introduced into this publication in 1999. Stage I classification refers to detainees who are required to attend a periodic detention centre during each detention period. Stage II detainees are not required to attend a periodic detention centre during each detention period, instead these detainees stay overnight in their own home and report to a work site or detention centre each day as required.

On summary sheets, Maximum security includes all unclassified inmates and both convicted and unconvicted inmates classified as A1, A2, E1. Medium security includes both convicted and unconvicted inmates classified as B, E2 and Category 4 and Minimum security includes both convicted and unconvidted inmates classified as C1, C2, C3 and Category 1, 2 and 3.

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

Parramatta Transitional Centre houses inmates serving full-time custodial sentences who have been temporarily released from a correctional centre under s29(1) of the Correctional Centres Act, 1952. The centre is designed to house female inmates involved in community based pre-release programs, however, it is not a gazetted correctional centre. Therefore these inmates are not included in totals for inmates held in correctional centres.

POLICE/COURT COMPLEXES Statistical Summary

The NSW Department of Corrective Services began manning court/police complexes in 1992. The very small number of inmates held overnight in these centres of detention have not been included in previous data collections as the scope of the Census was specifically for inmates held in gazetted correctional centres. In recent years the Department's responsibilities for inmates held in these centres has increased. The centres operate on a 24 hours basis and are used to manage the movement of inmates between courts and correctional centres. The numbers shown are for inmates held at midnight of the 30th June and do not represent the number of inmates passing through the centres throughout the day. These inmates are included here to represent the total number of persons held in the Department's custody, however, they have been excluded from the totals for inmates held in correctional centres.

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Figure 1: Trends in the gender of the inmate population (includes periodic detainees) as at the 30th June each year




Figure 2: Trends in the inmate custodial program (includes periodic detainees) as at the 30th June each year




Figure 3: Trends in the Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander status of inmates (includes periodic detainees) as at the 30th June each year




Figure 4: Trends in the legal status of inmates (includes periodic detainees) as at the 30th June each year

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


Figure 5: Trends in the security classification of convicted inmates (excludes periodic detainees)as at the 30th June each year





Figure 6: Trends in most serious offence (includes periodic detainees) as at the 30th June each year
