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EXPLANATORY NOTES

(a) General information

The New South Wales Inmate Census was conducted as part of the National Australian Prison Census for the 30th June 2006. The proposal for a National Prison Census first emerged at a Correctional Administrators meeting in Melbourne in September 1980 as an offshoot from a review of correctional statistics. Preliminary technical discussions were held in December 1980 and a formal proposal went to the Ministers Conference held in New Zealand in April/May 1981. The Ministers discussed the proposed census at some length and finally agreed to conduct the first Australian National Prison Census on 30th June 1982 and that an inmate census should continue to be conducted annually.

(b) Scope of data collection

This publication contains summary statistics of inmates held in full-time custody in gazetted correctional centres in New South Wales at midnight on the 30th June 2006 and of inmates with a "live" order for periodic detention as at 30th June 2006. Inmates temporarily absent from a correctional centre (as at midnight on Census night) under s26 of the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Act, 1999* have been excluded with the exception of those inmates housed at Parramatta Transitional Centre and Bolwara House Transitional Centre (Emu Plains). These inmates are shown separately (see Section 4) and are not included in any totals. Inmates (including Police custody (police-bail refused) detainees) housed in police/court complexes (places of detention not gazetted as correctional centres) under the supervision of Departmental staff have been included separately (Section 5) and are not included in any totals.

Inmates in Transitional Centres and Police/Court Complexes have been included in this publication as they are persons held in the custody of the NSW Department of Corrective Services. However, in order to maintain consistency in the scope for the Census data series, these inmates are not included in any totals for inmates held in gazetted correctional centres or periodic detention centres. A table detailing separate totals for all inmates is included as Table 7.1.

(c) Concept of an episode of imprisonment

Statistical information describing inmate legal status, type of sentence, court type, sentence terms, most serious offence etc. all relate to the episode of imprisonment current at the 30th June 2006. For the purposes of this publication, an episode of imprisonment is taken as a continuous period of imprisonment within an adult correctional centre in NSW.

In distinguishing between the current and any previous episode of imprisonment the following rules were applied:

- for inmates held in custody for breach of a parole or licence order relating to a previous period(s) of imprisonment, the previous period(s) of imprisonment is/are excluded from the current episode;
- ii. any period of imprisonment prior to a release to a court where the inmate was subsequently freed without having been returned to a correctional centre within 1 day, was excluded from the current episode;
- iii. any period of imprisonment prior to a release to police custody where the inmate was subsequently freed without having been returned to a correctional centre within 5 days, was excluded from the current episode;

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- iv. any period of imprisonment prior to release on bail, on a bond or to immigration authorities was excluded from the current episode;
- v. any period of imprisonment prior to transfer to an institution other than a NSW correctional centre (including Kariong Juvenile Correctional Centre), a transitional centre or police/court complex operated by the Department was excluded from the current episode. For example, this excludes detention in a psychiatric hospital, juvenile or interstate correctional institution.
- vi. for inmates who had escaped from the custody of the NSW Department of Corrective Services and had been subsequently returned to custody, the episode of imprisonment current at the time of the escape was included in the current episode;
- vii. for inmates who have had their periodic detention order cancelled and are serving the sentence by way of full-time imprisonment, or have been placed into full-time custody in relation to other offences, the period of periodic detention imprisonment was excluded from the current episode.
- viii. for inmates returned to periodic detention (after a period of full-time imprisonment) to serve the remainder of an original sentence by way of periodic detention, the period of full-time imprisonment is included in the current episode.

(d) Aboriginality – new methodology for determining current status

An inmate is recorded as an Aboriginal/TSI where they have identified as such in any current or historical episode.

(e) Known prior imprisonment as an adult

For the purposes of this publication known prior imprisonment includes any episode of imprisonment within a gazetted NSW correctional centre or periodic detention centres excluding Police/court cell complexes managed by the Department of Corrective Services. Prior to 1999, this category was based simply on whether a person had any known episode of prior imprisonment as an adult in a gazetted correctional centre in NSW. A hierarchy of sub-categories of known prior imprisonment based on custodial program and legal status was introduced in 1999. Where there is more than one period of prior imprisonment of a particular sub-category, the highest sub-category is used. The sub-categories, from lowest to highest, are:

- i. an episode of periodic detention;
- ii an episode on remand in a full-time correctional centre;
- iii. an episode in full-time custody for fine default;
- iv. an episode in full-time custody under sentence.

(f) English speaking status of country of birth

Country of birth classification is based on the Standard Australian Classification of Countries (SACC) (Australian Bureau of Statistics Catalogue No: 1269.0, ABS 1998). English speaking status of the country of birth is based on the "Main English speaking countries" as identified in ABS publication "Australian Standard Classification of Countries for Social Statistics" (ASCCSS) (ABS Catalogue No. 1269.0). The main English speaking countries comprise: Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Republic of Ireland, South Africa, United Kingdom (Channel Islands, England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland) and the United States of America).

(g) Legal status

For the purpose of this publication, inmates have been classified to the following eight legal status categories:

- i. under sentence no appeal;
- ii. convicted but awaiting sentence;
- iii. awaiting result of appeal against conviction or sentence;
- iv. detained as a forensic patient;
- v. unconvicted (awaiting court hearing/trial);
- vi. awaiting deportation;
- vii. awaiting extradition to another jurisdiction; or
- viii. civil inmate (held in custody for an offence other than a criminal offence).

(h) Type of sentence

This item relates to the aggregate sentence imposed (see explanatory note (m)). The category "Life sentence" includes (a) persons with an "existing Life sentence" (i.e. those sentenced to Life imprisonment under the legislation preceding the *Life Sentences Amendment Act, 1989* and who have yet to have the sentence redetermined by the Supreme Court), (b) persons sentenced to "Natural Life" under the *Crimes Act, 1900* as amended by the *Life Sentences Amendment Act, 1989* and (c) persons who have had an "existing Life sentence" redetermined to a sentence composed of a non-parole period of a term of years and a balance of sentence (i.e. parole period) of "Life".

The category "Forensic patient" is composed of those persons identified as "forensic patients" under the terms of the *Mental Health Act 1990*. This incorporates persons found not guilty by reason of mental illness, persons found unfit to be tried and persons certified to be mentally ill. Within the category of persons certified to be mentally ill, since 2006 only those who were held in a gazetted prison hospital (namely Long Bay Hospital) at the time of the census are recorded as "Forensic patients".

Inmates held in correctional centres (convicted or unconvicted) who also have a current order for periodic detention are counted as correctional centre inmates.

Amendments to the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners Act 1981 (Periodic Detention of Prisoners Amendment Act 1998 (No. 43))* enabled courts to set "minimum" and "additional" terms when imposing a sentence to be served by way of periodic detention. These changes were incorporated in the new legislation (Crimes (Sentencing Procedure) Act 1999) with respective changes to the sentence type terminology, as explained above. In this publication, periodic detention sentences are described as either "Periodic (Sentence/Non-Parole)" or "Periodic (Sentence/Parole declined)".

A new fine enforcement system for NSW was introduced from 27 January 1998 under the Fines Act 1996 and is based on a hierarchy of civil and non-custodial sanctions with imprisonment as a sanction of last resort. Inmates with a sentence type of "Fine default" are held only for reason of default on a commonwealth or interstate fine (i.e. there are no outstanding charges or current sentences).

(i) Level and State of court

This item represents the level and State of court at which (for sentenced inmates) the current sentence for the most serious offence was imposed. For unsentenced inmates, the court at which the most recent order for detention for the most serious offence (see explanatory note (k) below) is used. Appeal courts were recorded only where such courts have altered the length of sentence relating to the most serious offence. The court of conviction is shown as State Parole Authority (formerly the NSW Parole

Board) where the court of most serious offence was recorded as such. Inmates detained for reason of deportation only are shown under "Immigration Authority".

The NSW Drug Court program commenced on February 8, 1999 as a non-custodial program for illicit drug dependant offenders charged with non-violent offences. Inmates shown with a court of "Drug Court" are convicted offenders either (a) held in custody as unsentenced inmates by the Drug Court pending determination of or placement on their program, (b) in custody serving a "sanction" for a breach of the Drug Court order or (c) had had their program terminated and were subsequently ordered by the Drug Court to serve the original suspended sentence by imprisonment in full-time custody.

(j) Classification of offences

In this publication offences have been classified according to the Second Revision of the New South Wales Classification of Offences and of Care and Protection Orders for Children. This classification was developed by the NSW Office of the Australian Bureau of Statistics in collaboration with State authorities and has been used in NSW Correctional Centres and courts statistics since 1973.

As a general rule, a legal charge of attempting, conspiring, or inciting to commit a crime, or aiding in the commission of, or participating as an accessory before the fact to a crime is classified to the offence category to which the crime so attempted, etc. is assigned. However, cases of accessory after the fact to a crime are assigned to the category "Accessory after the fact". While the classification has, of necessity, been abbreviated in the tables that follow, detail of the specific offence groups included within each offence category are given in the Appendix.

(k) Most serious offence

Although an inmate may be held by the Department of Corrective Services for a number of different offences, only the most serious offence in the current imprisonment episode has been recorded in these statistics. The most serious offence is the offence for which the longest sentence was imposed for a single count regardless of the possible result of any appeals. Where no sentence had been imposed at 30 June 2006, or two different offences had equal sentences, the offence with the lowest (NSW) offence code number was chosen.

(I) Federal offences

The identification of inmates with federal offence(s) is based on the federal status all offences relating to the current imprisonment episode regardless of where a sentence had been imposed for that offence at the time of the census.

(m) Aggregate sentence

This item represents the longest period that a person may be detained under sentence in the current episode and includes any "balance of sentence" terms. Pending charges that are likely to extend the aggregate sentence are ignored. In the case of an inmate serving the balance of a sentence after revocation of parole or licence, only the balance of the sentence is included, as distinct from publications previous to 1998 where the whole of the original sentence was included.

The category "Forensic patient" includes all persons with a legal status or sentence type of "Forensic patient". The aggregate sentence length for "Life" and certain "Forensic patient" sentence types is indeterminate as the sentencing court does not impose a sentence expiry date for these sentences (refer to explanatory note (h) above).

(n) Inmate security classification

Inmates in correctional centres are classified in accordance with the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Regulation 2001* (Clauses 22, 23 and 24), incorporating the classification system for female inmates introduced on 4 July 1997. Inmate classification sub-categories for unsentenced inmates who have been classified were introduced into this publication in 1999. In this publication the inmate classification current at the 30 June 2006 is shown. It should be noted that some convicted inmates may have an "unconvicted" inmate classification if they were facing further and more serious charges or they had not been re-classified at the time of the Census.

The administratively based classification system for periodic detainees was introduced into this publication in 1999. Stage 1 classification refers to detainees who are required to attend a periodic detention centre during each detention period. Stage 2 detainees are not required to attend a periodic detention centre during each detention period, instead these detainees stay overnight in their own home and report to a work site or detention centre each day as required.

On summary sheets, Maximum security includes all unclassified inmates and both convicted and unconvicted inmates classified as AA, A1, A2, E1 and Category 5. Medium security includes both convicted and unconvicted inmates classified as B, E2 and Category 4 and Minimum security includes both convicted and unconvicted inmates classified as C1, C2, C3 and Category 1, 2 and 3.

(o) Significant events

The following is a summary of significant legislative and other operational changes that have been enacted since 30 June 2005 that may have impacted on the size and characteristics of the NSW inmate population:

- i. There were a number of changes to the operation of periodic detention centres, specifically:
 - o Parklea and Silverwater Periodic Detention Centres closed on 24 July 2005.
 - Metropolitan Periodic Detention Centre opened on 29 July 2005.
 - o Campbelltown Periodic Detention Centre closed on 9 January 2006.







Figure 1: Trends in the gender of the inmate population (includes periodic detention) as at 30th June each year




Figure 2: Trends in the inmate custodial program (includes periodic detention) as at 30th June each year




Figure 3: Trends in the Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander status of inmates (includes periodic detention) as at 30th June each year




Figure 4: Trends in the legal status of inmates (includes periodic detention) as at 30th June each year




Figure 5: Trends in the security classification of convicted inmates (excludes periodic detention) as at 30th June each year





Figure 6: Trends in most serious offence (includes periodic detention) as at 30th June each year


