1.	Has been charged with an offence within the jurisdiction of the Children's Court that is to be determined summarily.	
2.	Has indicated that he or she will plead guilty or has pleaded guilty to the offence or has had the offence proven after hearing.	
3.	Is descended from an Aboriginal person or Torres Strait Islander, identifies as an Aboriginal person or Torres Strait Islander and is accepted as such by the relevant community.	
5.	At a minimum, is highly likely to be sentenced to an order which would involve Juvenile Justice supervision.	
6.	Was 10 to less than 18 years of age at the time of the alleged commission of the offence(s) and under 19 years of age when proceedings commenced.	
7.	Has discussed the requirements of the YKC with his/her legal adviser and is willing to participate.

Part B: For completion by judicial officer who presided over hearing
