

Instrument of Delegation

Waiver of the Board's Fees

NSW Admission Board Rules 2015

The EO may not waive a fee payable in respect of courses of instruction conducted by the Law Extension Committee.2. A person aggrieved by a decision of the delegate may apply to the Board for a reconsideration of the matter.

The Authority given in this Instrument of Delegation continues until notice of cancellation is received from the Board at that time.

This Instrument of Delegation revokes any previous delegation referred to in Schedule 1 by any current Instrument of Delegation.
