

# Instrument of Delegation

## Approval of grant of financial relief to students-at-law in respect of the examination fee

*Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014*

The Legal Profession Admission Board of New South Wales (the Board) authorises the relevant body or position holder specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Instrument of Delegation to exercise the powers of the Board specified in column 2 of Schedule 1, subject to any conditions set out in Column 3 of Schedule 1.

This delegation is made pursuant to section 20A of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014*.

The EO is satisfied that the applicant for financial relief has established 'exceptional circumstances or compassionate grounds' for the grant of the financial relief.</li><li data-bbox="820 1234 1342 1330">2. Financial relief is limited to the financial limits specified in the Board's 'Refund Policy'.</li><li data-bbox="820 1352 1342 1514">3. Any application outside the scope of the Refund Policy or about which there is any doubt as to any of the above matters shall be referred to the Board for determination.</li><li data-bbox="820 1536 1342 1659">4. The EO is to report periodically to the Board on the number and types of grants of financial relief approved by the Executive Officer.</li></ol>

The Authority given in this Instrument is effective from the date of this delegation and continues until notice of cancellation is received from the Board at that time.
