

# Instrument of Delegation


## Practical Legal Training – Directions, Exemptions and Review of Decisions

The Legal Profession Admission Board of NSW (**the Board**), pursuant to Section 20A of the Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014 and Rule 30 of the Legal Profession Uniform Admission Rules 2015 (**UAR**), hereby delegates:

1. to the Practical Training Exemptions Sub-Committee, the power of the Board, under Rule 11 (2) and Rule 6 (4) of the UAR, to give practical training directions,
2. to the Practical Training Exemptions Sub-Committee, the power of the Board, under Section 18 of the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW) (**Uniform Law**), to exempt persons from satisfying the specified practical legal training prerequisite,
3. to the Legal Qualifications Committee, the power of the Board, under Rule 29 of the UAR, to review, vary or set aside any decision of the Practical Training Exemptions Sub-Committee in relation to any application made under Rule 11 (2) and Rule 6 (4) of the UAR, under Section 18 of the Uniform Law or under Rule 98 of the NSWABR in respect of practical legal training.

Upon its commencement this Instrument of Delegation replaces and revokes the 'Practical Legal Training - Directions, Exemptions and Review of Decisions' Instrument of Delegation executed by the Presiding Member on behalf of the Board on 27 May 2016.

The Authority given in this Instrument of Delegation continues until notice of cancellation is received from the Board at that time.
