Explanatory note

The object of this rule is to amend the NSW Admission Board Rules 2015 to increase the fees payable for the services provided by the Board and to introduce a fee for the criminal history report/check that an applicant for admission as a lawyer is required to provide as part of their application for admission and which is obtained by the Board on their behalf.

Name of Rule

This Rule is the NSW Admission Board Amendment (Fees) Rule 2026.

1 Commencement

This Rule commences on 1 July 2026 and is required to be Gazetted and notified on the Legal Profession Admission Board website.
